# #22 **is** (verb)

3rd person, singular, present form of *be*.

He is happy.

## #23 **she** (pronoun)

3rd person, singular, subject pronoun.  
Can refer to a female already mentioned.

She likes him.



*She* is also a noun or refers to a ship, but keep it simple for kids.

# #24 **was** (verb)

1st and 3rd person, singular, past tense of *be*.

She was happy.

1st person, plural, subject pronoun.

We are friends.

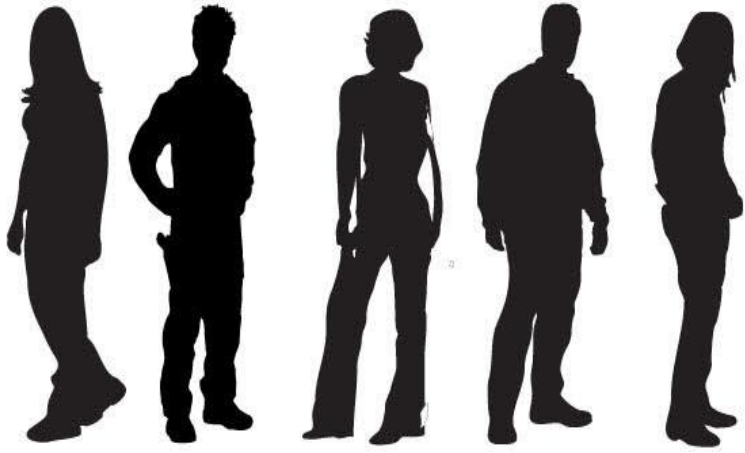
# #26 **are** (verb)

1st, 2nd and 3rd person, present tense, plural.  
Also, 2nd person present singular.

You are  
my friend.



Point Of View	Subject Pronoun	Present Tense	Past Tense
1 <sup>st</sup> person singular	I	am	was
1 <sup>st</sup> person plural	we	are	were
2 <sup>nd</sup> person singular	you	are	were
2 <sup>nd</sup> person plural	you	are	were
3 <sup>rd</sup> person singular male	he	is	was
3 <sup>rd</sup> person singular female	she	is	was
3 <sup>rd</sup> person singular non-human	it	is	was
3 <sup>rd</sup> person plural	they	are	were
