



#21 he (pronoun)

3rd person, singular, subject pronoun.

Refers to a previously mentioned male.

He likes me.





#22 is (verb)

3rd person, singular, present form of be.

He is happy.

#23 she (pronoun)

3rd person, singular, subject pronoun. Can refer to a female already mentioned.

She likes him.



She is also a noun or refers to a ship, but keep it simple for kids.

#24 **was** (verb)

1st and 3rd person, singular, past tense of be.

She was happy.

#25 **we** (pronoun)
1st person, plural, subject pronoun.

We are friends.




#26 **are** (verb)

1st, 2nd and 3rd person, present tense, plural. Also, 2nd person present singular.

You <u>are</u> my friend.

Of View	Pronoun	Tense	Tense
1 st person singular		am	was
1 st person plural	we	are	were
2 nd person singular	you	are	were
2 nd person plural	you	are	were
3 rd person singular male	he	is	was
3 rd person singular female	she	is	was
3 rd person singular non-human	it	is	was
3 rd person plural	they	are	were



#27 us (pronoun)

Do you like us?



There are seven basic object pronouns (me, you, him, her, it, us & them).

#28 **but** (conjunction) Contrast what was previously stated.

She went to the movies, but I went to the football game.





Can also be other parts of speech.



#29 said (verb)

Simple past and past participle of say.

She said, "I love you."





#30 help (verb)

Will you help us?



(interjection) <u>Help!</u> My socks smell awful.
