#242 believe (verb)

I believe (an opinion, accept something to be true without proof, capable, etc.) they will win the game.





relieve

#243 relieve (verb)

I do back bridges to relieve (to lessen, make the pain go away) my back pain.





receive

#244 receive (verb)

It's better to give than receive

(to accept something).





deceive

#245 deceive (verb)

A friend will never deceive

(trick for an advantage) you.





receipt

#246 receipt (noun)

Be sure to get a receipt

(proof you paid for something) When

you buy clothes.






