## #242 **believe** (verb)

to be true without proof, capable, etc.)*

**they will win the game.**

**#243 relieve (verb)**

**I do back bridges to**  
**relieve** *(to lessen, make the pain*  
*go away)* **my back pain.**





receive

## #244 **receive** (verb)

It's better to give than receive

*(to accept something).*







deceive

#245 **deceive** (verb)

A friend will never deceive  
*(trick for an advantage)* you.

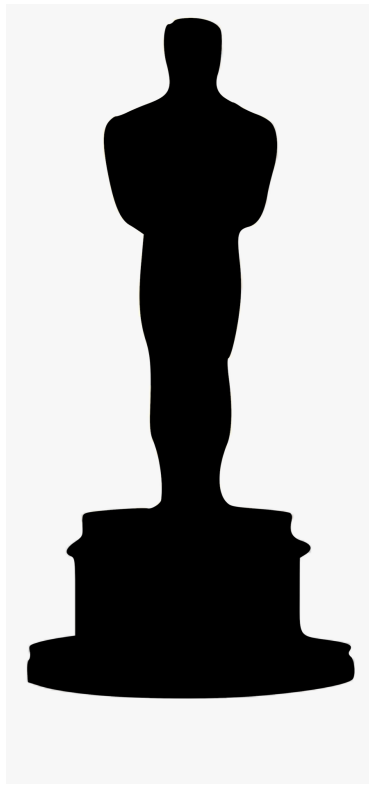




## #246 **receipt** (noun)

Be sure to get a receipt  
(*proof you paid for something*) **when**  
**you buy clothes.**

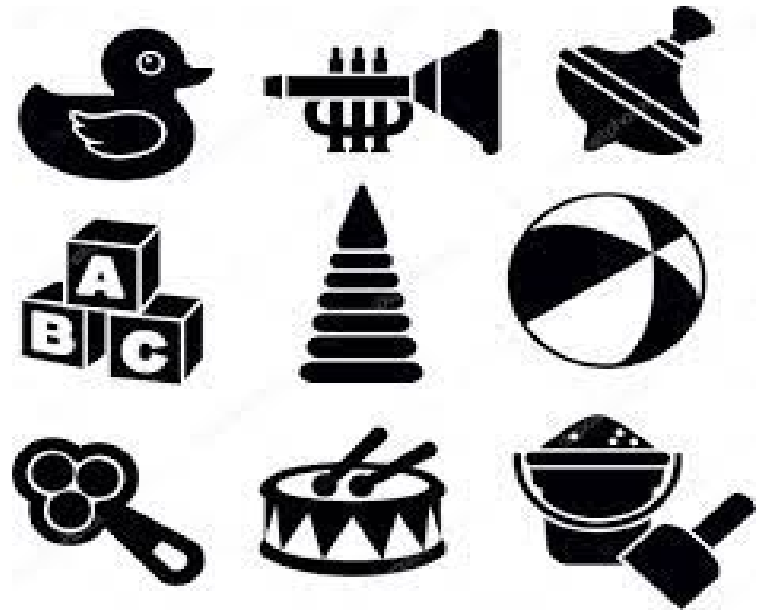

## #248 **forward** (adjective)

The forward (*moving towards a direction*)  
pass was legalized in 1906.

Do not add an "s" with adjectives.



(adverb) Forget it and move forwards (*to the future*).

For adverbs, the "s" is the writer's choice.

(verb) Please forward (send) me the email.
