(a series of rows placed one above another).



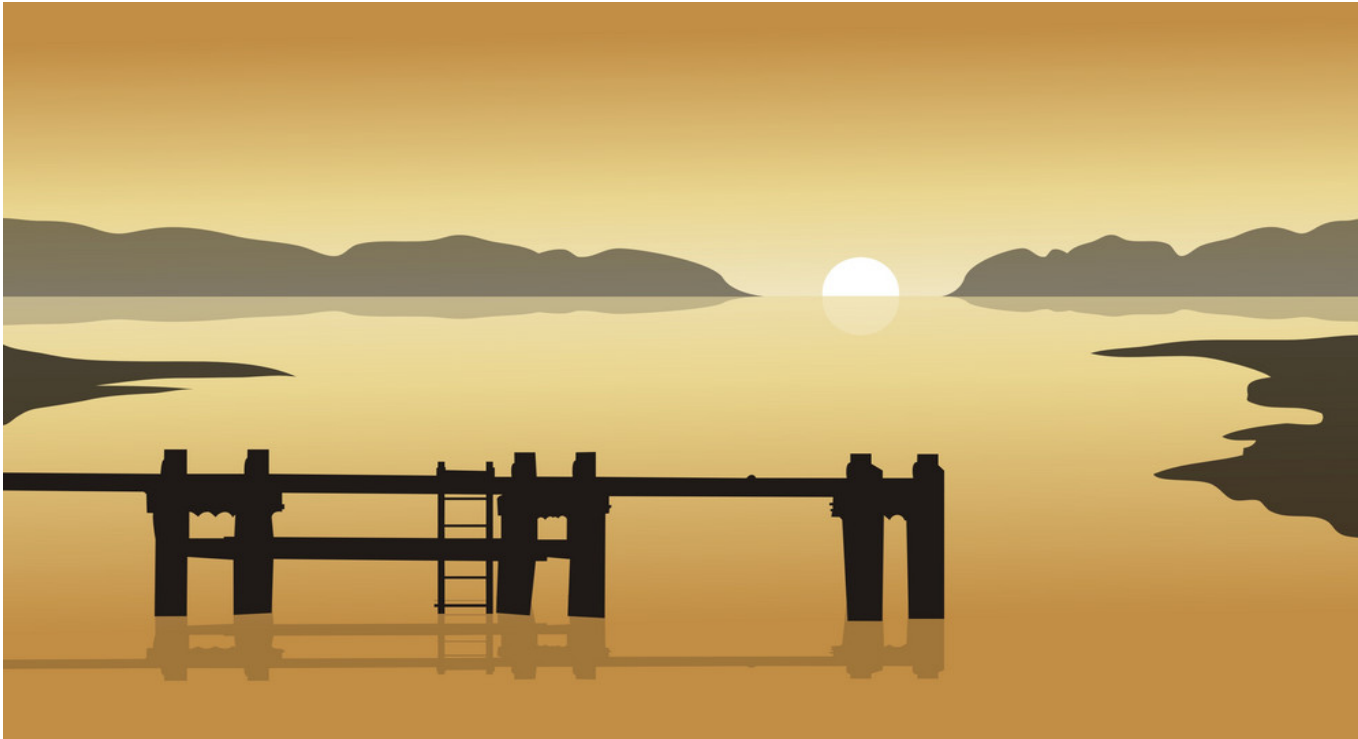


pier

Self Contained Underwater Breathing Apparatus.)**

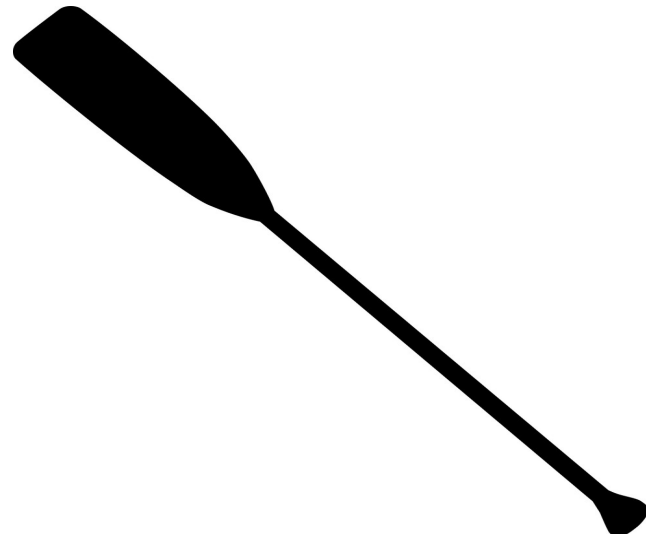


canoe

#255 canoe (noun)

oar

#256 oar (noun)

An oar has one blade and connects to a vessel.



Paddles can have one or two blades and are not connected to a vessel.



soar

#257 soar (verb)

**I saw an eagle soar (*fly*)
over the water.**





calm

#258 calm (adjective)

**He told me to keep calm
(relaxed).**



(verb) Deep breathing will calm you down.



water

#259 water (noun)

The water is calm.



(verb) Please water the flowers.



perfect

#260 perfect (adjective) /perfikt/

**Today is a perfect (*ideal, no mistakes*)
day to go for a walk.**



**(verb) Please help me perfect (*as good as possible*)
throwing technique. /perfekt/**
