#### Who had an excused <u>absence</u> (not present) from school?



# A sponge can <u>absorb</u> (soak up) liquids.






# accept

#### I lost my keys; the only <u>access</u> (to enter) was through a window.






### accident

### Be careful, I don't want an accident (unexpected injury or meeting someone by chance).



# My friend will accompany (go along with) us.






### accurate

# Take your time and be accurate (exact, correct).







# adequate

# You did an <u>adequate</u> (acceptable) job on the test.






# address
