for the job is...



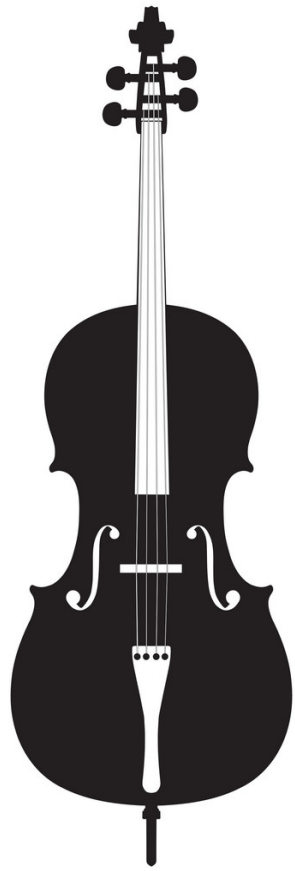


cauliflower

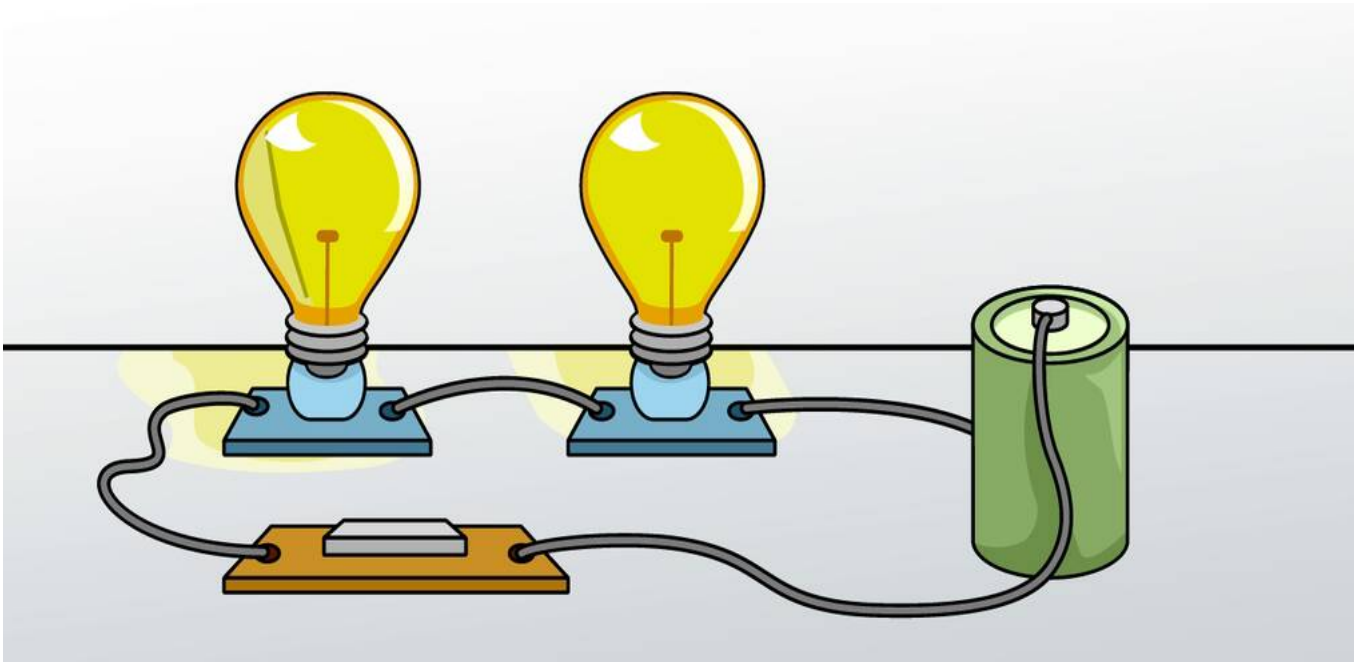
cinnamon

an Asian tree.**





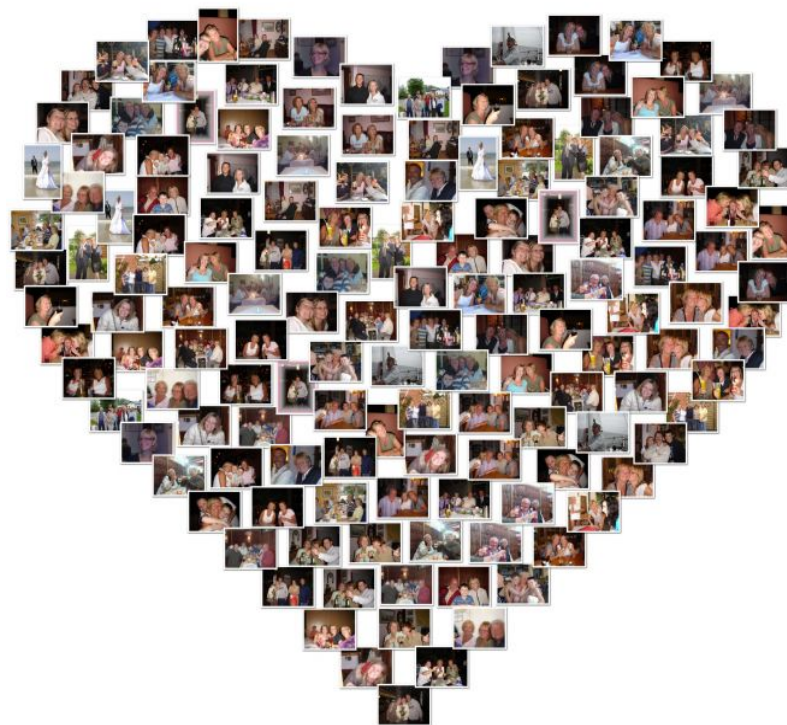
circuit
