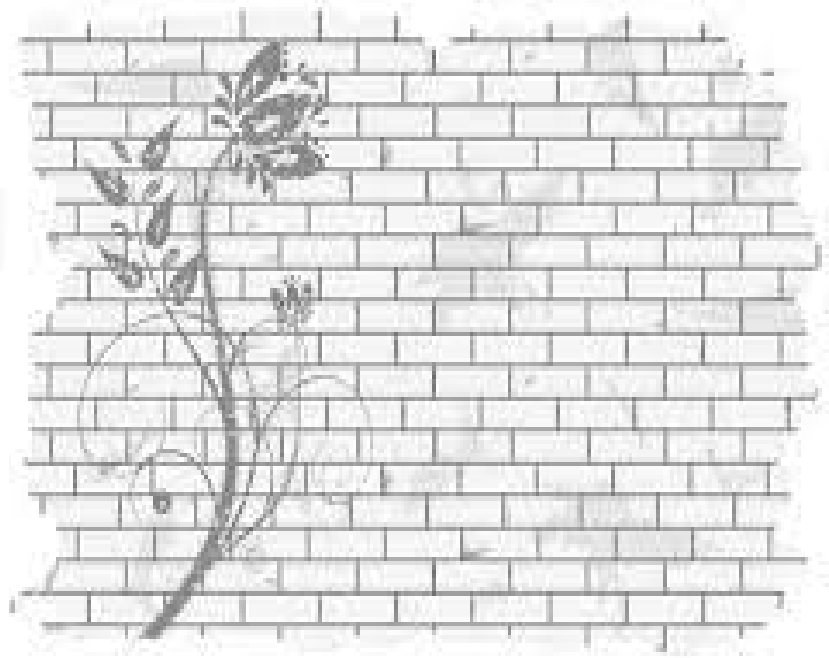
#341 government (noun)

a ton!"

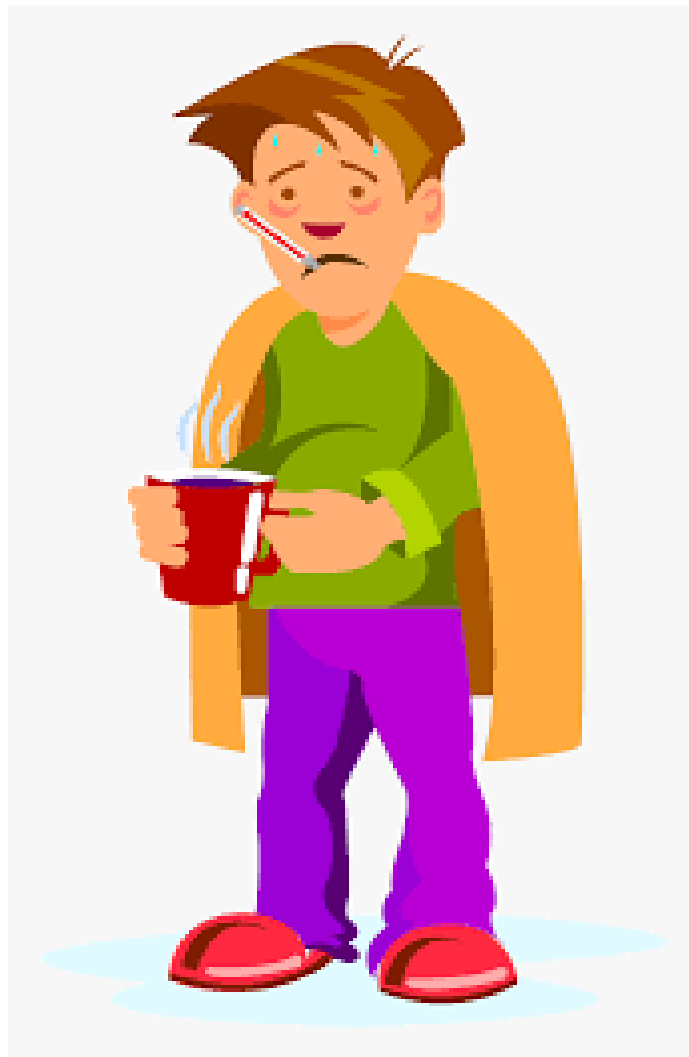
hyperbole

(A person exaggerates their illness or are not really sick.)



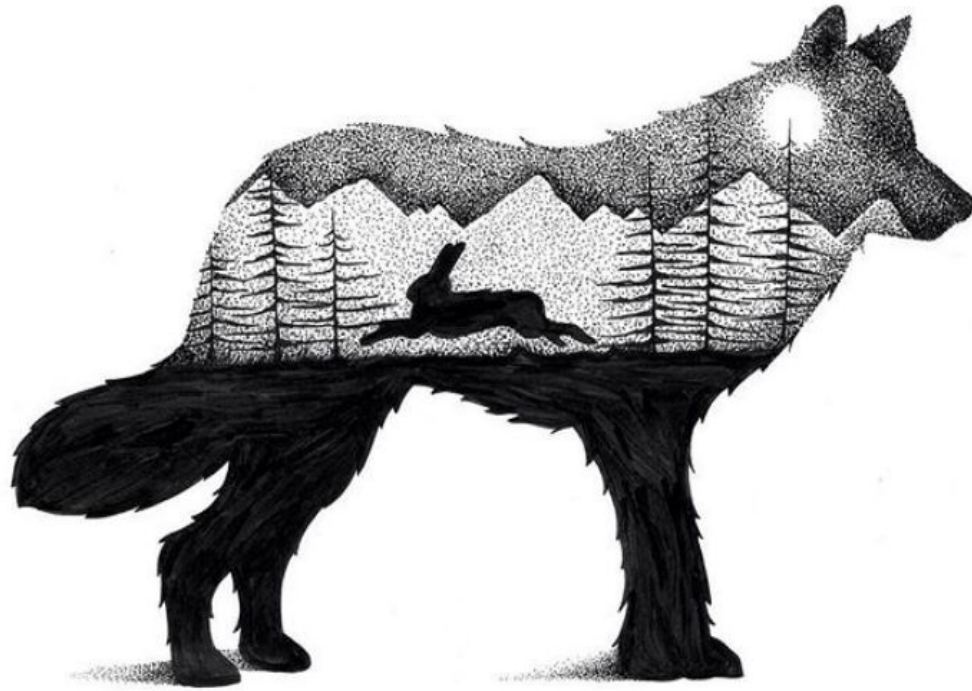


intimate

(*close, personal*) letter.**

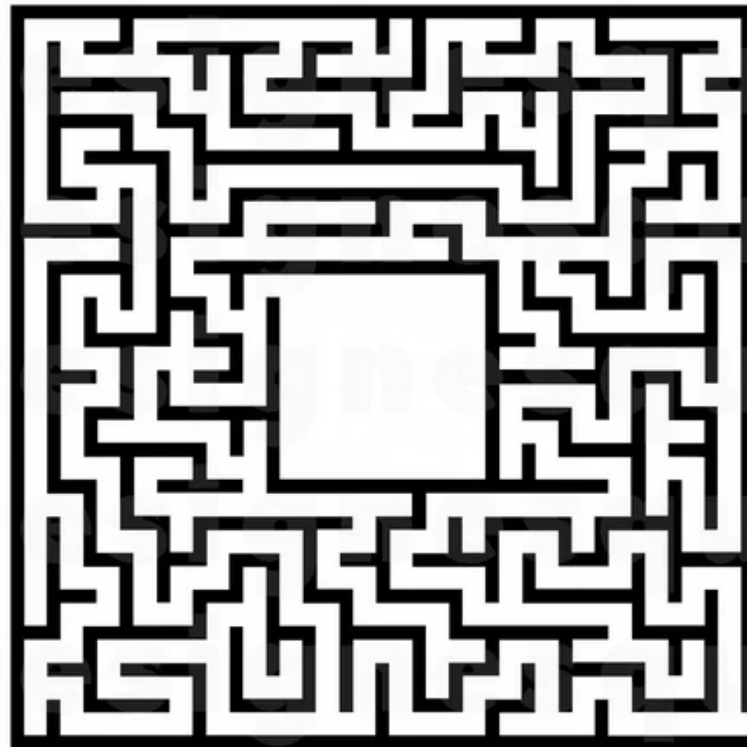




intricate
