(*permission to use something*)?





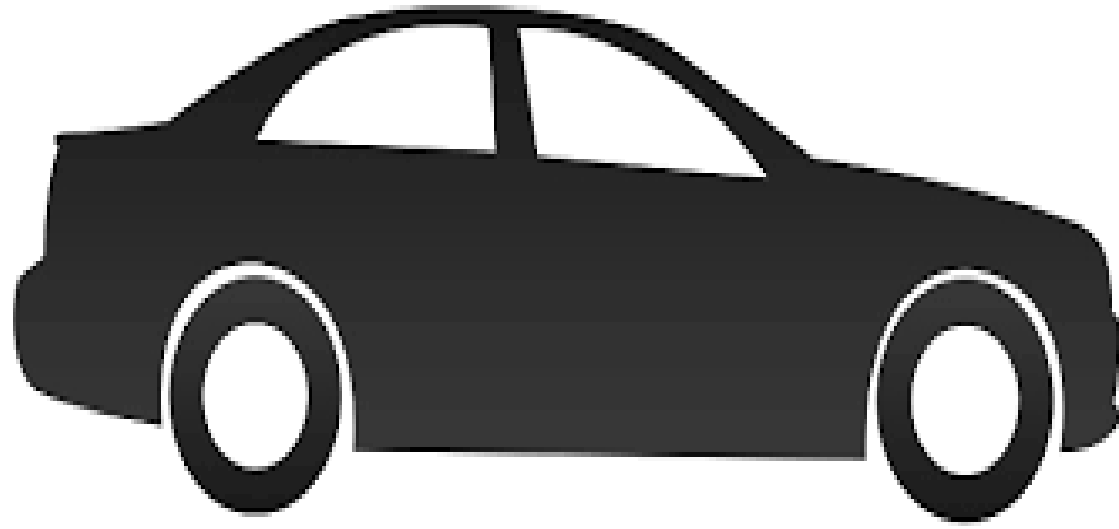
library

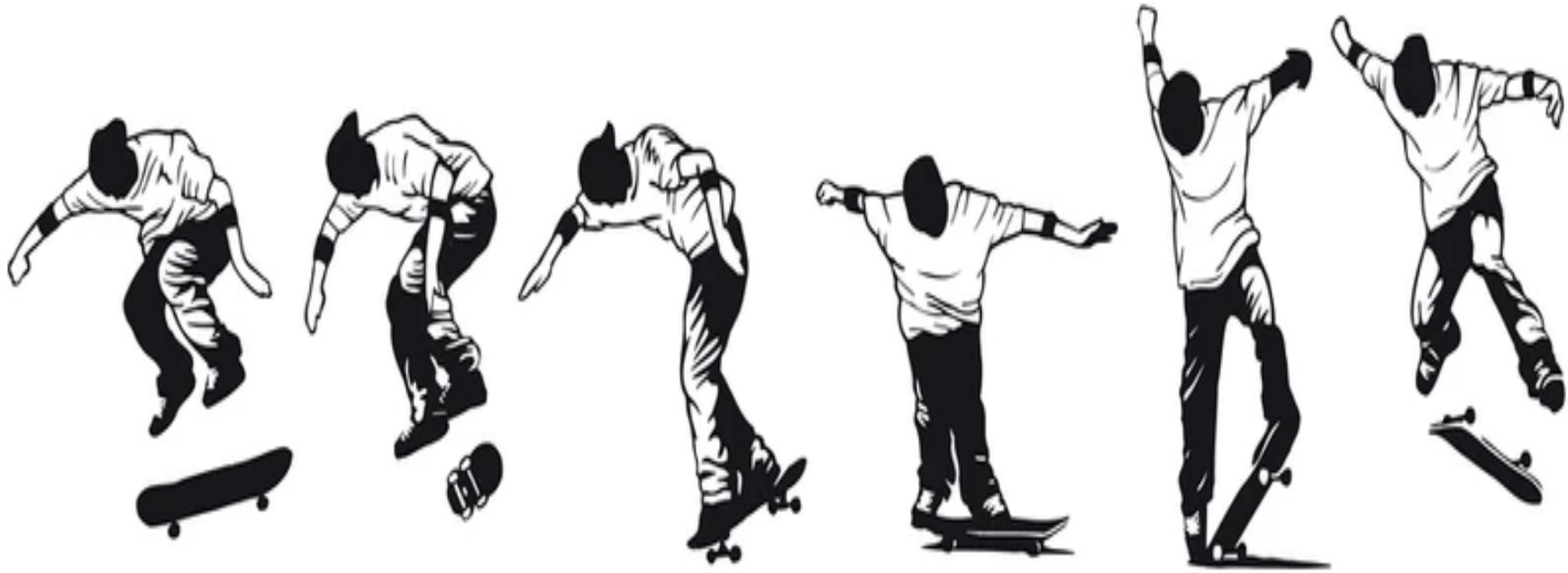
machine

is the wheel.

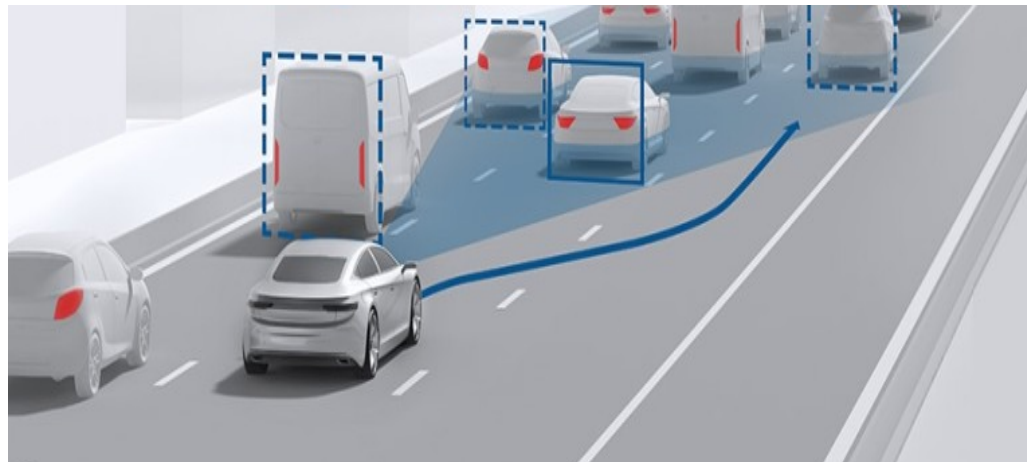




maneuver

marshmallow

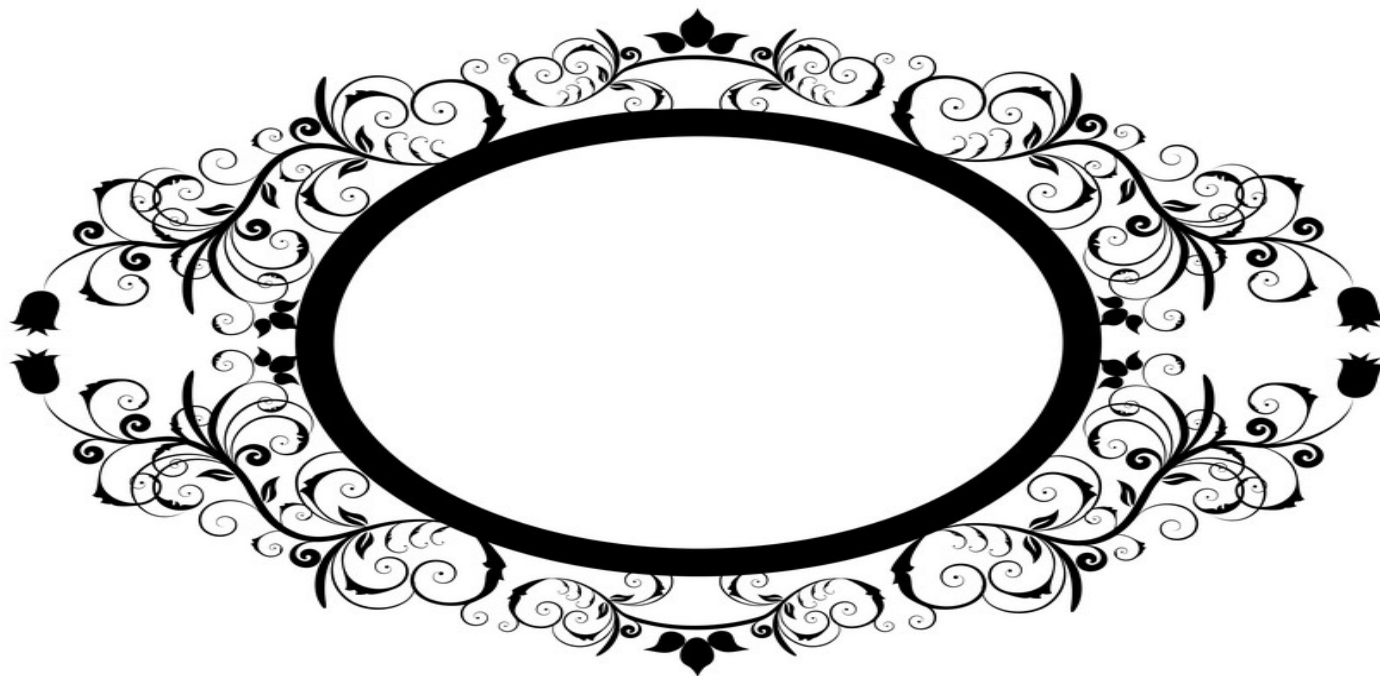
#359 marshmallow (noun)
