Modern music makes me nauseous


(disgusted over something).

### neither

#367 **neither** (adverb)
You should not do it, <u>neither</u>
(not either of two things) would they.

(conjunction) <u>Neither</u> Mrs. Snakehead nor Mr. Orangehead are here.

(adjective) Neither sock smells any good.

(pronoun) Neither of the girls are going.

# A daughter of a person's brother or sister is called a niece.





## nostalgia

#### #369 nostalgia (noun)

# A pleasant memory of the past is called nostalgia.





### OCCASION

#370 occasion (noun)

### Her birthday is always an important occasion

(a special event).

(verb) It happened to me on more than one occasion (a specific event).
