A refrigerator is an appliance that keeps food cold (used in homes since 1913).






regime

#396 rendezvous (noun)


They planned a rendezvous (meeting at an agreed place and time) for their ten-year anniversary.

(verb) We will <u>resume</u> (start again) after a five minute break. /re zoom/




rhythm m

#400 sabotage (verb)
