#41 **any** (adjective)

Do you have any
(a non-specific amount) candy?

(adverb) Do you feel any
(emphasizes to what degree) better?

(pronoun) I looked for candy
but could not find any.



many

#42 **many** (adjective)

Many (*a large number, majority*)
people will join us for lunch.

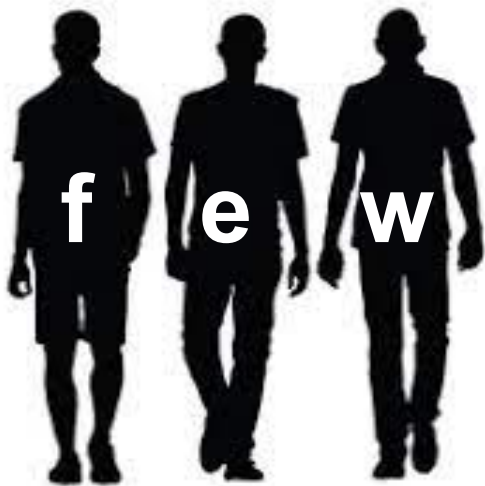




few

#43 **few** (adjective)

Very few (*a small number, minority*)
people think like us.

#44 **will** (verb)

You will do
a good job
on the test.



English does not have a future tense.

We use certain words that refer to the future
(will, shall, am going to, is going to, are going to, etc).

who

#45 who (pronoun)

Can refer to an individual or a group.

**Guess who will be playing a
rock concert tonight?**



what

#46 what (pronoun)

What is her name?

To request information.



where

#47 where (adverb)

Where *(location)* do you live?



when

#48 **when** (adverb)

When (*what time*)
will you play
video games?



Can be other parts of speech.

why

#49 **why** (adverb)

Why (*for what reason*)
did you eat my candy?



Can be other parts of speech.

how

#50 how (adverb)

**How (*in what way*)
was your lunch?**
