




terrific

#422 tomorrow (noun) Tomorrow will be another great day!




(adverb) The game will be played tomorrow.

#423 unanimous (adjective)

#424 unsuccessful (adjective)

#425 vaccine (noun)

Vaccine (a substance that makes a body stronger against an infection) for polio (a disease).

If a person hurts you, then you injure them in return, that is <u>vengeance</u>.






Vinegar
