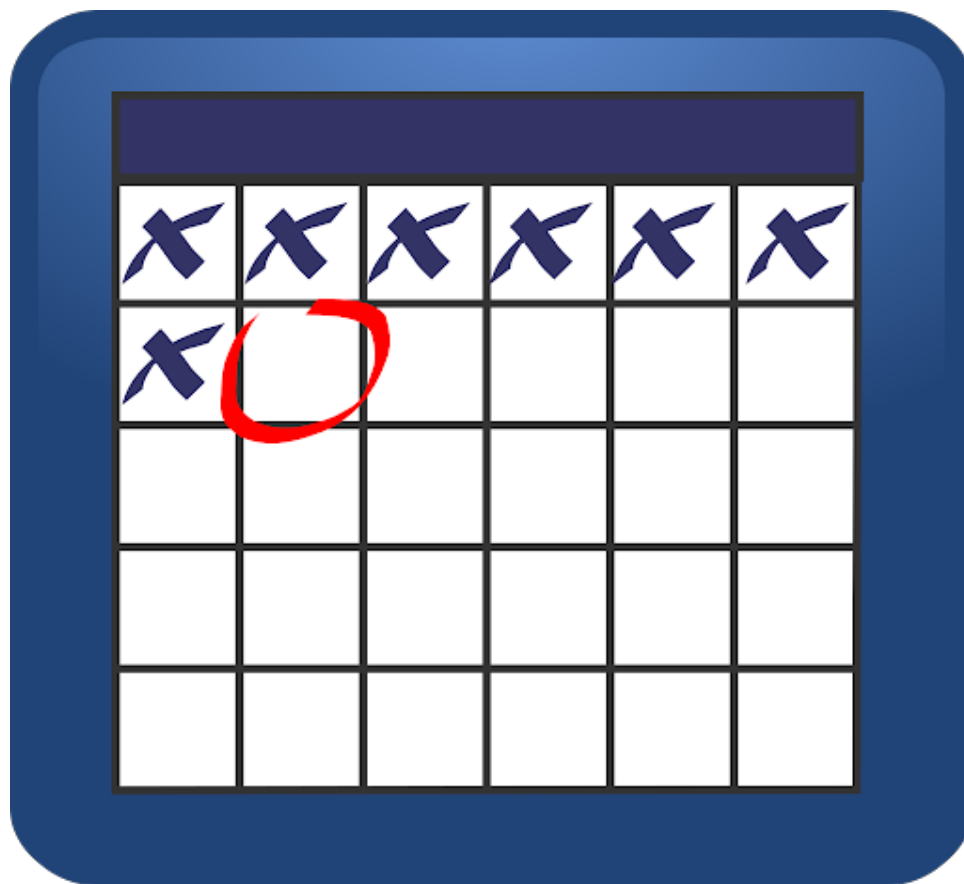
terrific

another great day!



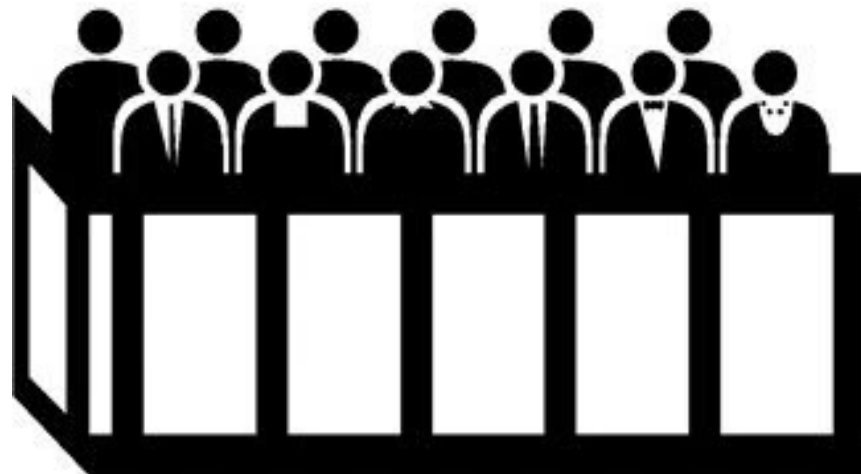
(adverb) The game will be played tomorrow.

than their talent.

#425 vaccine (noun)

Jonas Salk developed a
vaccine *(a substance that makes a*
body stronger against an infection)
for polio *(a disease).*

#426 **vacuum** (noun)

Please plug in the
vacuum (*cleans a carpet*).





vengeance

#427 vengeance (noun)

**If a person hurts you,
then you injure them in
return, that is vengeance.**



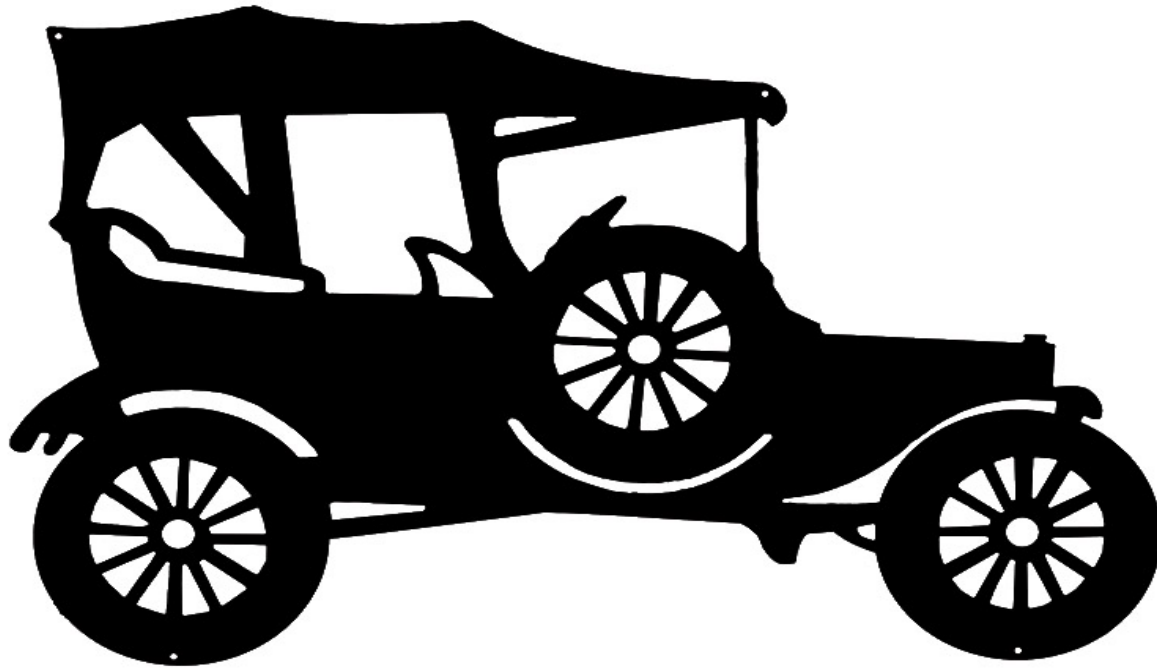


vinegar
