



#81 **love** (verb)

I love you.



(noun) Is this love?



dove

#82 **dove** (noun)

A dove is a bird
that symbolizes peace.



(Irregular verb) Dove is past tense of dive.

He dove
in the water.





move

#83 **move** (verb)

Please help
me move

(from one place to another)

a heavy box.



(noun) I am watching your every move.



prove

#84 **prove** (verb)

She can not prove

(show evidence that something is true)

that I ate a cookie.



some

#85 **some** (adjective)

Some (*an unspecified amount*)

days I feel sick.



(pronoun) Some of my friends will be coming over to watch the game.

Can also be an adverb and even a suffix. That is awesome!

come

#86 **come** (verb)

Your socks stink; don't come
(move towards a speaker) **any closer.**

2 nd person	have	have	had	had
3 rd person	has	have	had	had

has

#87 **has** (verb)

Has means to request, hold, possess, etc.

He has a handful of grapes.



She has an apple.



It has a banana.

have

#88 **have** (verb)

Have is the third person, singular, present tense that means to have or own.

**May I have
a slice of
cake?**

had

#89 **had** (verb)

Past tense and past participle of have, irregular verb.

**I had
money
in my
pocket.**





they

#90 **they** (pronoun)

Refers to two or more things or people.

They are my friends.



They is slowly becoming a gender neutral, singular pronoun.
