#441 anecdote (noun) /an ek dōte/

**The teacher shared an
anecdote (*a short interesting or
funny story*) about failing a
test; therefore,
the class was at ease.**



anguish

#442 anguish (verb) /ang wish/

He was deeply anguished
(mental and/or physical suffering
causing misery) **after the**
Minnesota Vikings lost.

(noun) The sports fan screamed out in anguish.



apparel

#443 **apparel** (noun) /u pair el/

He bought sports
apparel (*clothing*).





architect

#444 architect (noun) /ar ku tekt/

**Would you
like to be an
architect**

***(a person who
designs buildings)?***





asphyxiate

#445 asphyxiate (verb) /as fix ēē āte/

**The massive
amounts of
smoke caused
him to asphyxiate**



(unconsciousness or death from lack of air).

auxiliary

#446 auxiliary (noun) /og zil yu rēe/

An auxiliary (*helping*) verb is found before the main verb.

Auxiliary has other meanings, to give support (*adjective or noun*) or audio related equipment.



barbecue

#447 **barbecue** (noun) /bar bēē q/

Barbecue (*food, usually meat,
cooked on a grill [outdoors]*)

is cooked over a flame.

(verb) Did he **barbecue** the chicken?



camouflage

#448 **camouflage** (noun) /ca mu flazh/

A leopard has spots for camouflage
(*a disguise to blend in with the one's
surroundings*) from predators.



(verb) The military jeep is
camouflaged from the enemy.



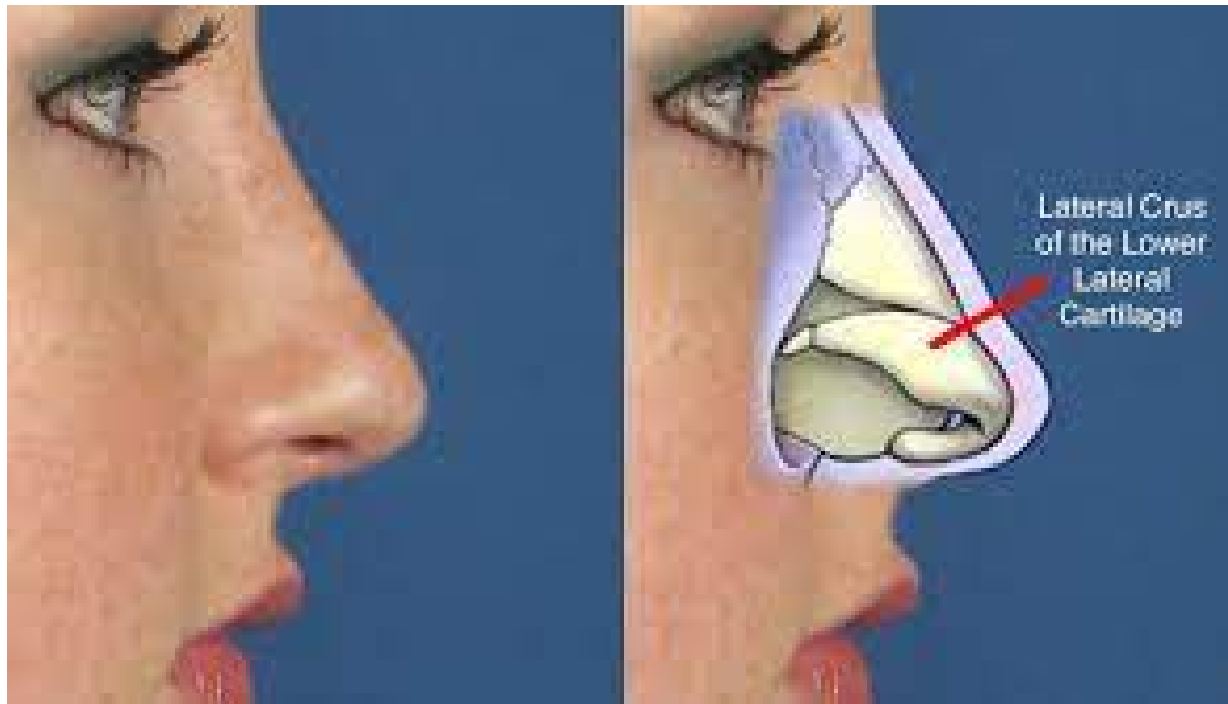
Caribbean

#449 **Caribbean** (noun) /ka rib bē in/

There are 13 independent countries in the Caribbean

(islands and a sea near the Americas).





cartilage

#450 **cartilage** (noun) /kar ti lij/

He hurt the cartilage

*(a tissue that is strong and flexible;
it cushions bones
at the joints and
is parts of the
nose and ears)
in his knee.*
