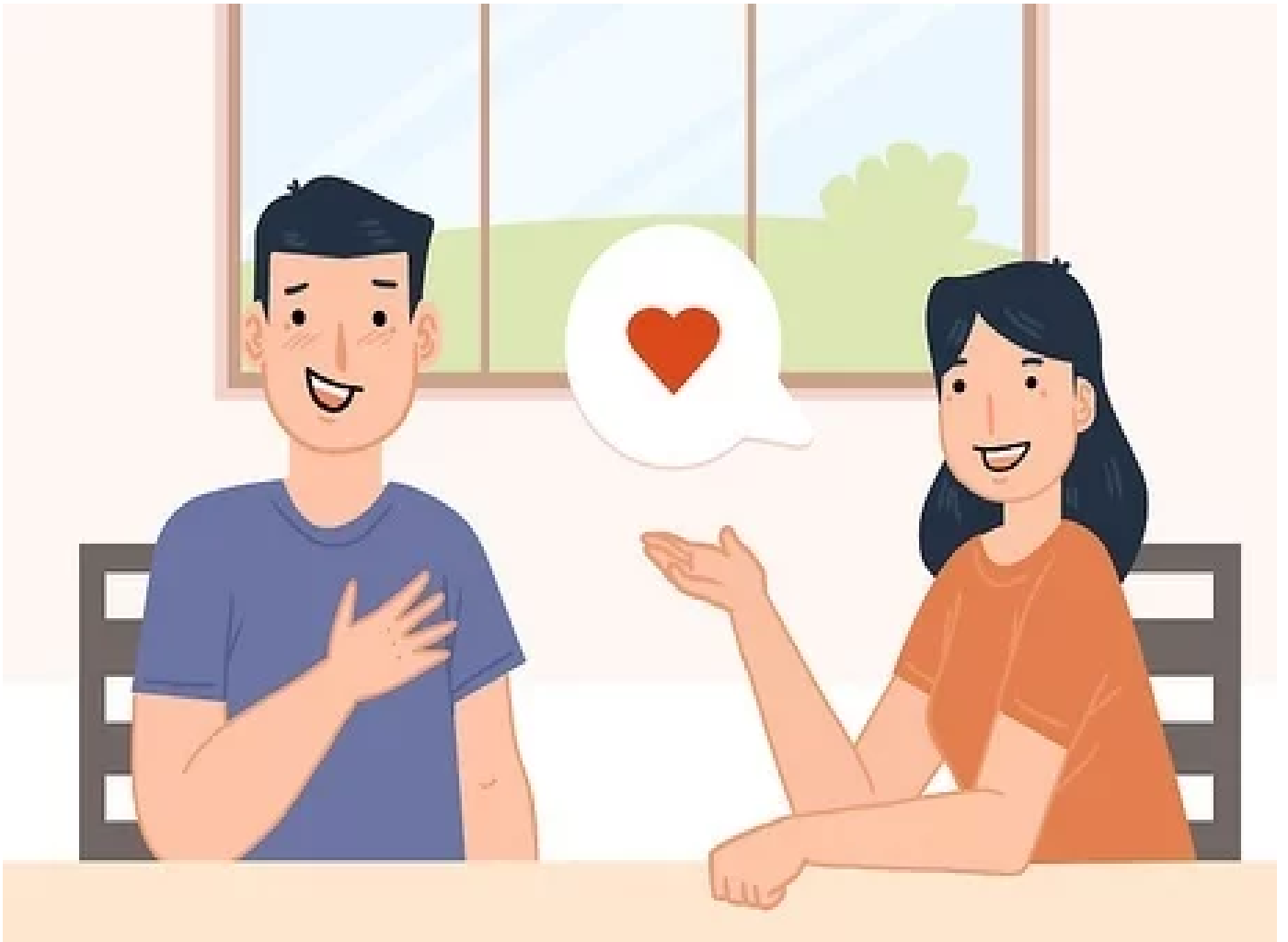

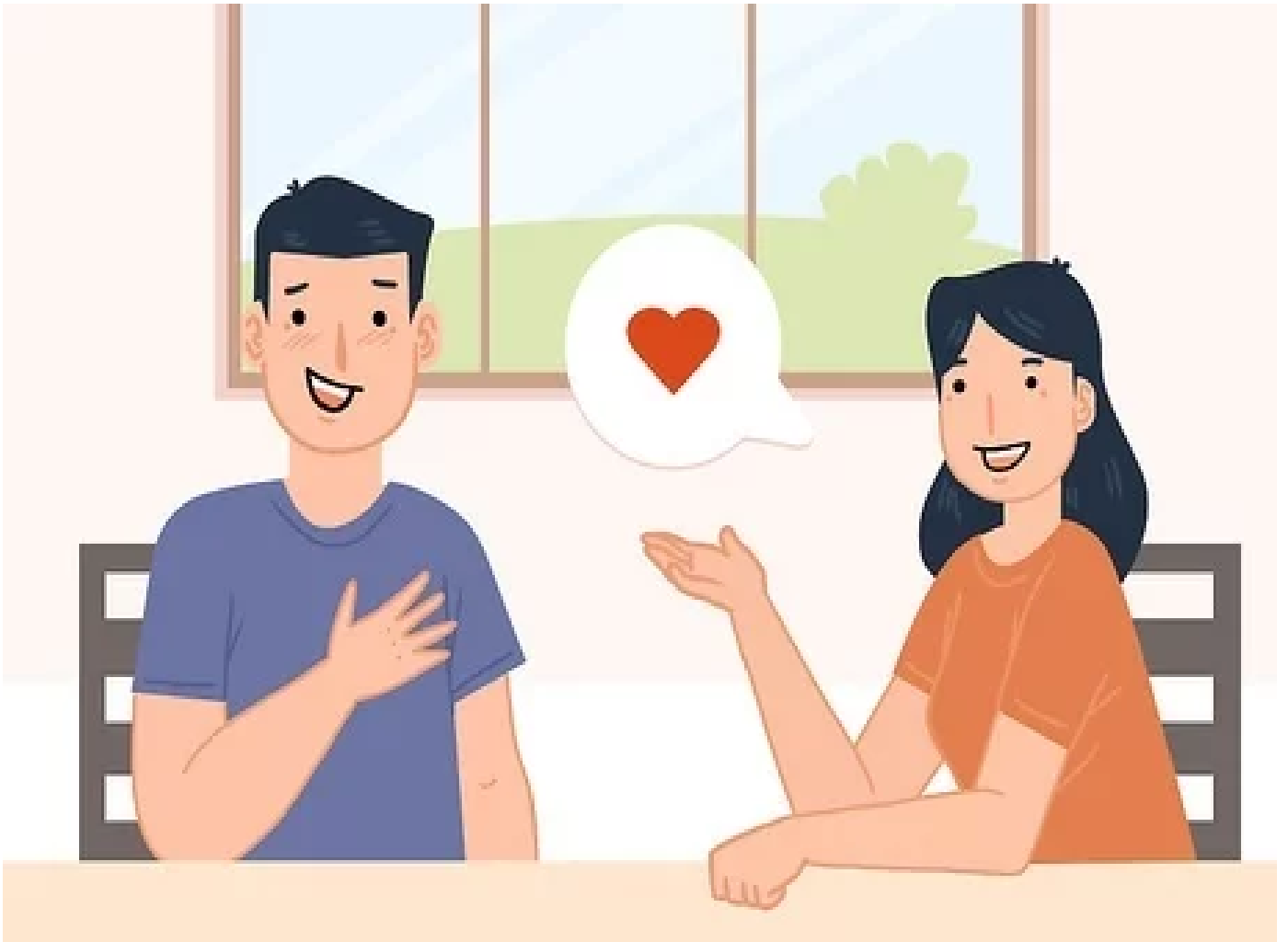

# said or told

**Both of these words  
are irregular verbs.**

**Some hints:**

**We use *say/said* before a quote.**

*Our teacher **said**, "Students, I know  
how many Super Bowls the Vikings lost."*

**We usually use *tell/told* if the next word  
is a noun/pronoun (indirect object).**

*"I **told** you the answer yesterday."*
