anytime vs any time

Anytime (adverb) means regardless of time.

"You can arrive anytime."
Anytime can be replaced with whenever.

Any time (a noun phrase) refers to an amount of time.

"We don't have any time for complainers!"

Notice how any time can <u>not</u> be replaced with whenever.
