

**GAME:** *Where is the object?*

**BEST TIME TO PLAY:** *Sight Words #47 where, #97 eraser & #98 crayon,*

**OBJECT OF GAME:** *Student(s) must guess who has the object (an eraser, etc).*

- \* The object can be any small item that is safely passed around, e.g., a squishy ball if teaching the Word Family 008 ALL, or something that relates to a recent science lesson.
- \* Random Popsicle sticks with the student's names determine who are the observers.
- \* The teacher gives a student an item, and that object is discreetly passed around while music before 1979 is playing.
- \* After one minute, the observing students must guess *where is the object*. Keep it simple at first; the object must remain in a student's hand. Two points can be awarded to the person who is correct. If the observers are incorrect, the students who secretly passed the object get a point!
