

Phrasal Verb **talk down**

To negotiate a lower price.



**He wanted too much money;
*I talked him down.***

Phrasal Verb **talk down**

To speak to someone as if they are not as good as you.



It is better to remain silent than talk down to someone.

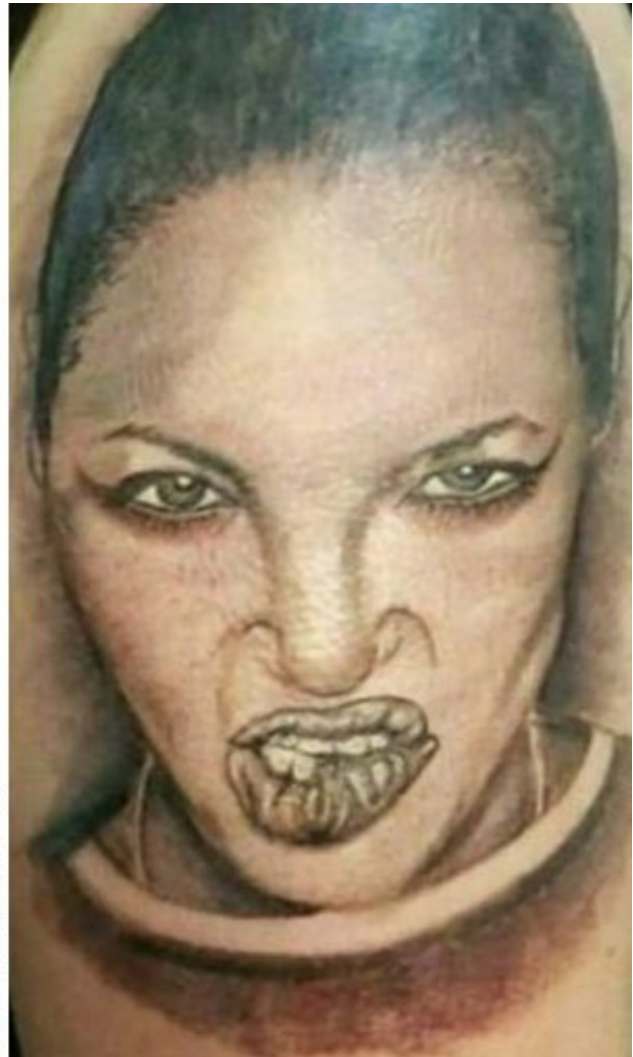
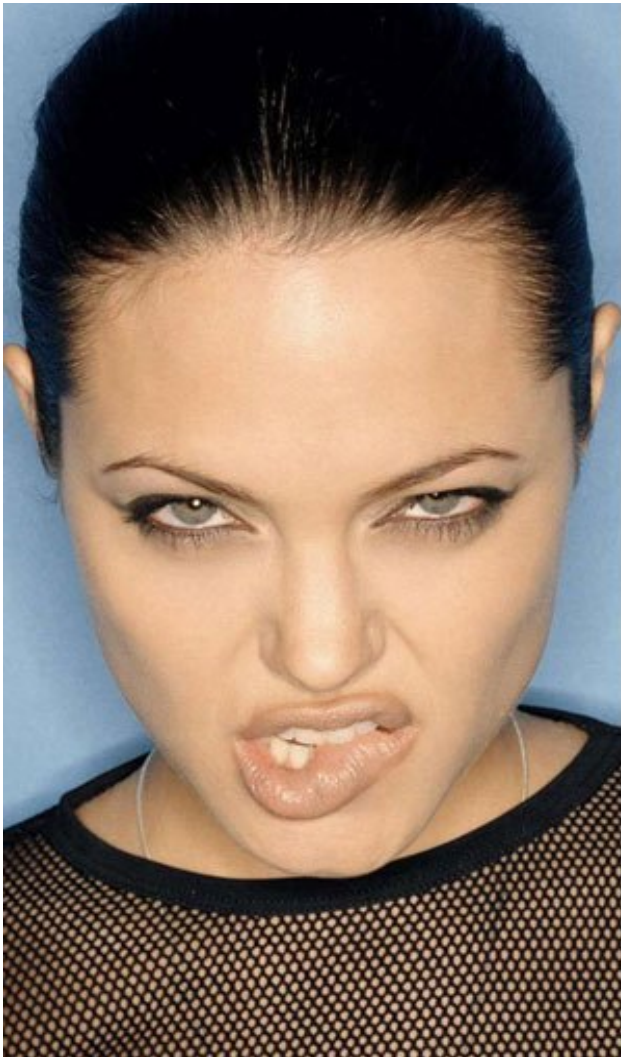
Phrasal Verb **talk into**

Convince another into doing something.



**Did anyone *talk* him into
getting a tattoo from
a lousy artist?**

Phrasal Verb **talk out of**
Convince another into
not doing something.



Someone should have *talked*
him *out of* letting that "artist"
give him a tattoo.

Phrasal Verb **talk over**
To discuss something.



"WE NEVER TALK ANYMORE SINCE
YOU STARTED FACEBOOK!"

We disagreed, but we
talked over our problem.

Talk over can also mean speak louder than another noise.

Phrasal Verb **talk through**

**To discuss or instruct someone
step by step.**



**The process is easy.
I will talk *you* through it.**
