

## Step #9 The Verb "Have"

Point of view	Present singular	Present plural	Past singular	Past plural
1 <sup>st</sup> person	have	have	had	had
2 <sup>nd</sup> person	have	have	had	had
3 <sup>rd</sup> person	has	have	had	had

### Present singular

**1st person-** "I have a chart on irregular verbs."

**2nd person-** "You have glasses to read my chart."

**3rd person-** "She has practiced writing sentences with verbs."

### Present plural

**1st person-** "We have a chart on irregular verbs."

**2nd person-** "You have glasses to read my chart."

**3rd person-** "They have practiced writing sentences with verbs."

### Past singular

**1st person-** "I had a chart on irregular verbs."

**2nd person-** "You had glasses to read my chart."

**3rd person-** "She had practiced writing sentences with verbs..."\*

### Past plural

**1st person-** "We had a chart on irregular verbs."

**2nd person-** "You had glasses to read my chart."

**3rd person-** "They had practiced writing sentences with verbs..."\*

*\* When I teach you Aspects, a subcategory of tenses, you will learn some sentences need a second event.*
