Present plural

1st person- "We have a chart on irregular verbs."

2nd person- "You have glasses to read my chart."

3rd person- "They have practiced writing sentences with verbs."

Past singular

1st person- "I had a chart on irregular verbs."

2nd person- "You had glasses to read my chart."

3rd person- "She <u>had</u> practiced writing sentences with verbs..."*

Past plural

1st person- "We had a chart on irregular verbs."

2nd person- "You had glasses to read my chart."

3rd person- "They had practiced writing sentences with verbs..."*
