Not all adjectives can have a comparative or a superlative (dead/deader/deadest).

One adjective I find interesting is <u>favorite</u> (what one likes the best).

My brother has a favorite hockey team (St. Louis Blues), a favorite baseball team (St. Louis Cardinals), and a favorite football team (Minnesota Vikings).

Among those three favorites, the Vikings are his *most favorite*.

I feel *most favorite* is acceptable while I can't think of a sentence where *more favorite* can be used.
