


A curtain is a piece of fabric or other material that hangs in a window, shower, etc.






Curtains are fabric panels used to cover windows, and are generally cut to fit a window or drop a few centimetres below it.

Drapes are also fabric panels but are generally made from thicker fabrics and cut to floor length or to slightly puddle on the floor.

The play is about to begin, and the curtain will rise.





(performers bow after a performance).




#### The Iron Curtain
