This time, less people laughed.

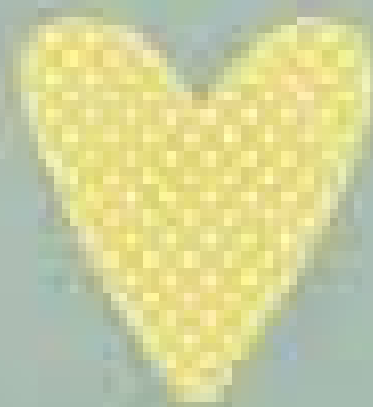
