(*a word that resembles its sound*).**



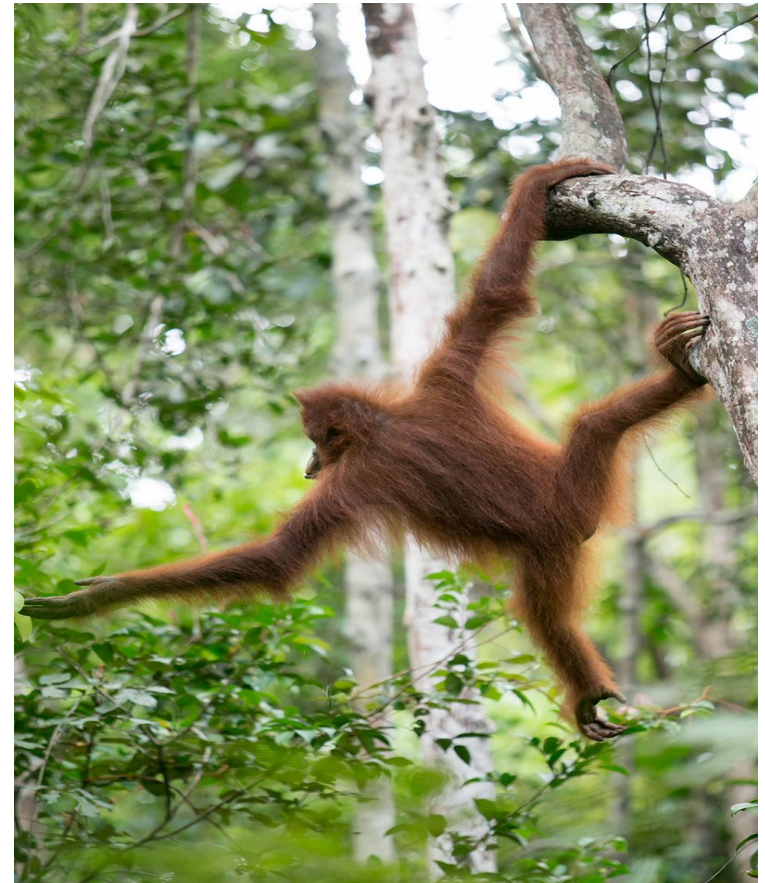


orangutan

writes plays).*



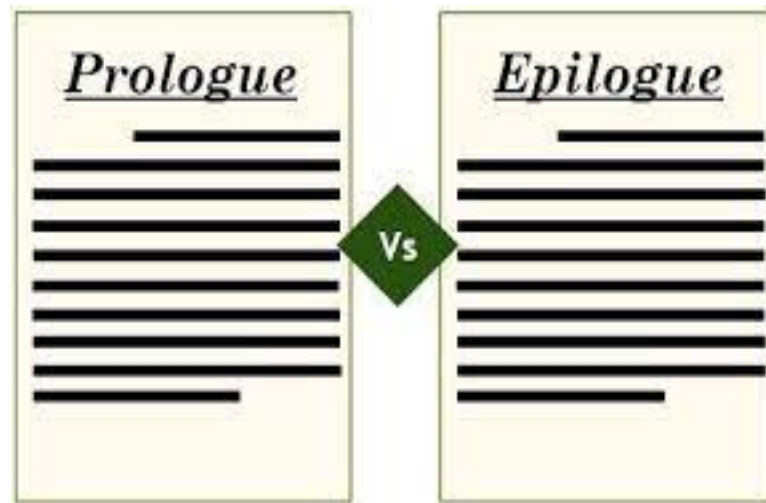


prologue
