

(present) **stink** (past) **stank** (past participle) **stunk**



Present tense/Base form PU, those socks stink.

Simple past Thankfully he washed the socks, they stank.

Past participle (add a helping verb) Those socks could not have stunk any worse.

Present participle (stinking) Throw those stinking socks in the garbage!

3rd person, present singular (stinks) A sock stinks.

Remember, the verb after he, she or it gets the added S.

Infinitive (to stink) He is "talented"; it takes him very little time to stink a sock.
