(present) stink (past) stank (past participle) stunk



Present tense/Base form PU, those socks stink.

Simple past <u>Thankfully he washed the socks</u>, <u>they stank</u>.

Past participle (add a helping verb) Those socks could not have stunk any worse.

Present participle (stinking) <u>Throw those</u> <u>stinking socks in the garbage!</u>
3rd person, present singular (stinks) <u>A sock stinks.</u>

Remember, the verb after he, she or it gets the added S.

Infinitive (to stink) <u>He is "talented"; it takes</u> him very little time to stink a sock.
