(present) shrink (past) shrank/shrunk (past participle) shrunk



Present tense/Base form <u>Did you shrink my</u> <u>sweater?</u>

Simple past No, the dryer shrank it.

No, the dryer shrunk it.

Past participle (add a helping verb) The dryer could have shrunk it even more!

Present participle (shrinking) You are always shrinking my sweaters!

3rd person, present singular (shrinks) You know a sweater shrinks in the dryer.

Infinitive (to shrink) <u>I think she makes it a</u> point to shrink my sweaters.
