Object Pronouns

Object pronouns receive the action. They also help keep a sentence from sounding redundant.

Object pronouns can replace a previously mentioned noun.

"My brother and I love our *TV* (object); we appreciate *it* (object)."

What do my brother and I love?

The TV of course!

What do we appreciate?

It, another name for the previously mentioned TV.

1 st person plural	we	us
2 nd person singular	you	you
2 nd person plural	you	you
3 rd person singular male	he	him
3 rd person singular female	she	her
3 rd person singular non-human	it	it
3 rd person plural	they	them
