Simple Past... **spun**

Past Participle... **spun**

Present Participle... **spinning**

3rd person, Present Singular... **spins**

Infinitive... **to spin**

1. Watch the teacher \_\_\_\_\_ in his chair.
2. He \_\_\_\_\_ before each class.
3. One time, he \_\_\_\_\_ so fast, he flew into the hallway.
4. If he is going \_\_\_\_\_, he must be careful.
5. He had \_\_\_\_\_ so much, his head was dizzy.
6. \_\_\_\_\_ makes me feel sick.

# Irregular Verb

Present Tense/Base form... **spin**

Simple Past... **spun**

Past Participle... **spun**

Present Participle... **spinning**

3rd person, Present Singular... **spins**

Infinitive... **to spin**

1. Watch the teacher **spin** in his chair.
2. He **spins** before each class.
3. One time, he **spun** so fast, he flew into the hallway.
4. If he is going **to spin**, he must be careful.
5. He **had spun** so much, his head was dizzy.

The helping verb *had* shows one event happened before another.  
Common sense also tells us the order of events.

I prefer to use only *had* as a helping verb to make things clear.

6. **Spinning** makes me feel sick.
