


## Simon Says



Let's learn prepositions of location while we play Simon Says.





## ADVANCED TABLE SETTING



## We are going to play Simon Says with plasticware (and maybe more items).



Give each student the desired items.

## Let's begin the game!





For this game of Simon Says, tell students you will be keeping track\* and announce the winner at the end of the game.

Minutes later, tell the class everyone is a winner!

Each student writes their name on a raffle ticket to be put into a hat. Discreetly put the name of the desired winner inside the sweatband/liner.

Mix the tickets like it is legitimate, close your eyes, and then look surprised when you select the name of the person you want to win.

<sup>\*</sup> You are actually performing an assessment on who has learned what.

Simon Says: Put the knife, fork and spoon on the plate.

Simon Says: Stand up and push your chair under the table.
