The **A B C** of Salvation

A - Agree:

The first thing we must do is to **agree** with what God says about us. The Bible says: “*for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God*” Romans 3:23. There are no exceptions to this.

Christ is God’s perfect standard that we must **measure** ourselves by. And **all** fall short of this!

God is perfect in all His ways. His Son, Jesus Christ lived a perfect life. The Bible says that He is holy, harmless and undefiled in all His ways.

For Christ did no sin, knew no sin, and in Him there is no sin. He was God manifest in flesh.

We must **agree** that all are sinful in His eyes. There are **NO** exceptions to this rule. The Bible says our sins have separated us from our God.

We must **agree** with the truth about ourselves as taught by Jesus. By humbling ourselves, we begin our journey back to God. God exalts the humble and He brings down the proud. Jesus took a small child and said, “*Whoever humbles himself as this little child is the greatest in the kingdom of heaven*” Matthew 18:4.

B – Believe:

The Bible also says: “***Believe on the Lord Jesus Christ, and you will be saved***” Acts 16:31.

Believe that Jesus Christ died for your sins, and fully paid the penalty that God demands, the penalty that we deserve and cannot repay.

Believe that only Christ was perfect enough to redeem us, and there are no religious observances that can save us from sin’s penalty.

Believe Christ died personally for you. He died as a sacrifice for your sins, for “*In Him we have redemption through His blood, the forgiveness of sins, according to the riches of His grace*” Eph 1:7.

C – Confess:

Confess means to own up to Him for our wrong doing and **repent**, meaning to have a change of heart about sin and our need of His forgiveness.

The Bible says, “*that if you confess with your mouth the Lord Jesus and believe in your heart that God has raised Him from the dead, you will be saved*” Romans 10:9. You **will** be saved!
