How the Auction will work:

1. Items for sale are described in this catalogue, using descriptions and photos provided by the person donating the object.
2. Advance bids are invited and should be sent to auction@titsey.org.uk to arrive on or before Tuesday 12 January 2021 - please give Lot Number, value of bid and your name.
3. On the night our auctioneers will announce each item in turn (in the order presented in this catalogue), they will also indicate the amount of the highest advance bid and seek further bids from the Zoom audience by stating a new amount.
4. When bidding please remember that it will be your responsibility to collect the item from the seller. (See item 8 below.)
5. To place a bid on the night please raise your hand (physically or by using the Raise Hand feature in Zoom, not the 'reaction' button as that disappears after a few seconds) in response to the auctioneer's new value. If you want to jump to a higher amount please unmute and do so!
6. If your bid is successful the auctioneer will confirm your name and the amount paid. Our Recorder (Chris Todd) will note down the details.
7. After the Auction you should do an online transfer to the value of your successful bid to:


Please give your name and the lot number as the reference. If buying more than one item please do separate transfers.






Lot 2: Book: Christmas at the Island Hotel




