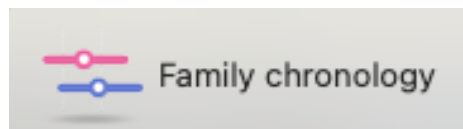

FAMILY CHRONOLOGY

The Family Chronology, the flagship function of Heredis 2024, is a new document that will delight all genealogists, as it gives them access to a display of their genealogy in a way never seen before!

They can see how their family history unfolded over time, and put their ancestors in the context of the period in which they lived, thanks to the timeline.

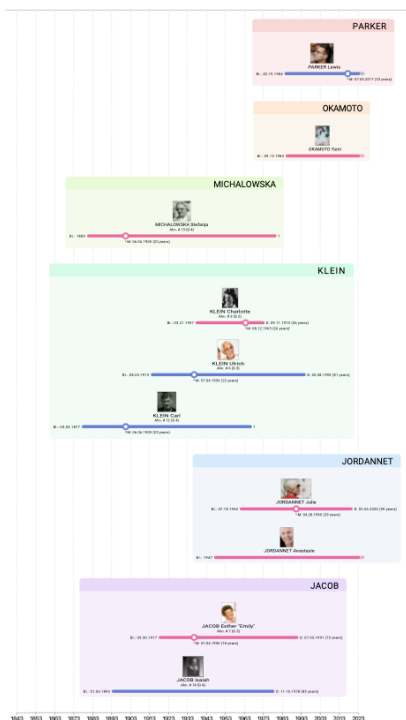


This view allows you to compare the lives of several ancestors in your family tree at a glance, to imagine overlapping lives and who knew whom! For example, with the Family Chronology, it's easy to find out which of a person's four grandparents

was born first, how old they were when each of them died, and so on.

This document also highlights gaps in your genealogy for certain periods: grouping your ancestors by place of birth, for example, to fill in missing or erroneous elements. It's a great way to make progress in your genealogy!

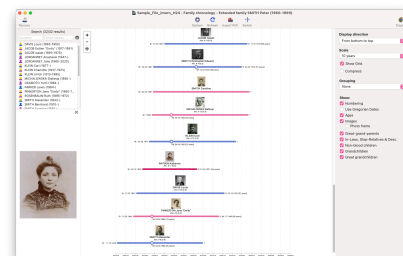
Genealogists can also group these Family Chronologies by surname if they are doing specific work, or if they want to have an overview of the surnames in their genealogy.



You can also display the ancestors you wish over periods of time using the intelligent search: ideal if you want to highlight certain surnames in your genealogy or a particular place.

It's also easy to spot all those who are not blood-related to the primary person, indicated in italics.

Last but not least, this document is an excellent basis for illustrating an ancestor's biography! Genealogists can print it out and insert it into their genealogical documents.

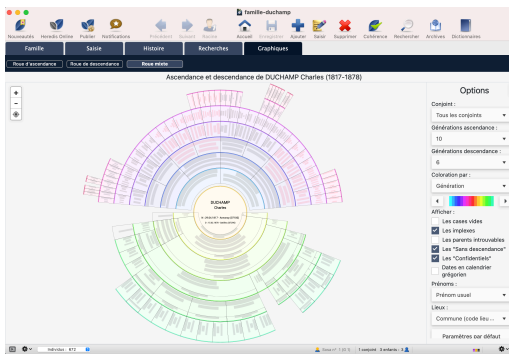

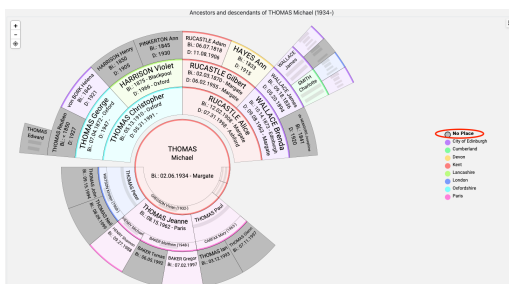

In view of this success, we have responded to our users' requests, and **all the wheels now benefit from the advances made in Heredis 2024**. For the Mixed Wheel and the Descendants Wheel, genealogists can now display the primary person with his or her spouse, or his or her SPOUSES if he or she has had more than one. This enables a more detailed analysis of their descendants! They can also highlight individuals who have no place of birth. This new feature can reveal the gaps that may exist for certain individuals!



Finally, confidential individuals can be hidden, location formats can be selected and export titles can be hidden.

IMPROVEMENTS

The team is constantly improving the software's functionality and ease of use.

Here are just a few examples:

- **Place format:** genealogists can now display places as they wish in index cards, books and wheels! They can choose the format: simply City, City with postal code, City with abbreviated postal code, City with county, City with state/province, City with country, state/province, Country, complete place, or

just the postal code or abbreviated postal code, etc.

- **Renaming media:** one small step forward but one GIANT leap for Heredis genealogists. Users can rename their media from the media index or the Photo tool.
- **Data protection:** there is private or confidential information in our trees that should not be shared. That's why Heredis has taken a number of steps in this direction! From the media index, you can now select several media and make them private in 2 clicks. It is now possible to hide confidential individuals in graphs: useful when you want to distribute a wheel containing confidential information.
- **Prepare your file for transmission:** the "Prepare to transmit" function compresses your entire file with its associated media so that it can be easily opened with all other Heredis applications: from a Mac to a PC, from a PC to a Mac, from an iOS device to a PC, from a Mac to an Android device... This new Heredis file format makes it very easy to share your tree in an unlimited way, since the size can now exceed 2 GB per file.

MASTERCLASS

A new Heredis product: MasterClass Heredis 2024: in addition to their new software, Heredis 2024 users can order tutorial videos to learn more about their software! In the form of short videos, they have access to ten videos to learn more about the basic functions of their software. Heredis 2024 software installation backup is also available!
